- Pay \$22 per test fee
- Pre-register with the Learning Lab
- Offered the first of every month at the WG Campus.

### Rifle Adult High School Diploma Program Requirements:

- Not enrolled in another high school program
- Live in RE-2 school district for at least one year
- Must be 18-years-old to receive diploma
- Complete Admissions interview, application and transcript eval
- Complete GED and required CMC coursework
- Exit interview
