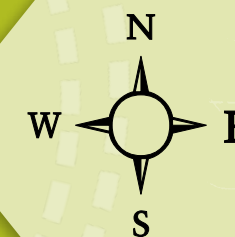

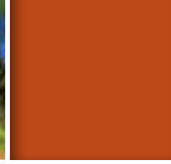

Uniquely CMC

- ▶ **Highest elevated college** campus in the U.S. (Timberline Campus, elevation 10,152 ft.)
- ▶ A recent Student Engagement Survey **rated CMC faculty & staff highest** in Colorado for helpfulness, availability and flexibility.

Eleven learning locations provide liberal arts and science certificate and degree programs, basic and lifelong learning, occupational training and custom business training across 12,000 square miles of western Colorado. CMC prepares Colorado's workforce through apprenticeships, internships and experiential learning.
