## I. INTRODUCTION

Ennovate Corporation, on behalf of Colorado Mountain College (CMC), is soliciting proposals from natural gas suppliers to supply natural gas to CMC's various facilities.

Your company's Proposal should include the price, terms, and conditions under which you are willing to provide an uninterrupted supply of natural gas to the facilities pursuant to the terms of this RFP. Ennovate and CMC anticipates that, based on its review and evaluation of the Proposals received pursuant to this RFP, it will select a proposer ("Respondent") and execute a contract ("Contract") pursuant to which the Respondent will render the services to CMC, in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in the Contract and this RFP.

## II. TIMELINE

The following timeline outlines the proposal, selection, and construction process. Ennovate and CMC reserve the right to alter the timeline at any point. All prospective Respondents will be notified if any changes are made prior to the Proposal Submission Deadline.

### III. NATURAL GAS REQUIREMENTS

**VI. TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

A. PROPRIETARY INFORMATION

Clearly mark any information considered proprietary. If the selection committee concurs with the designation, the information will remain confidential.

B. SIGNATURE BLOCK

Proposal must be signed by an authorized agent of the firm. Sign proposal indicate the firm has read and understood the requirements of the RFP and the Terms and Conditions.

C. REFUSAL

Ennovate and CMC reserve the right to refuse any and/or all proposals. This RFP does not represent a commitment by Ennovate or CMC to do business with any offeror. Nothing set forth in this RFP is binding on Ennovate or CMC as any terms and conditions related to the services contemplated by this RFP will be set forth in a definitive Contract to be executed by CMC and the selected Respondent. Ennovate or CMC may, in its sole discretion, elect not to award a Contract pursuant to this RFP.

D. WITHDRAWAL

A firm may withdraw their proposal at any time prior to the submission deadline.

E. NEGOTIATIONS

Ennovate and CMC reserve the right to conduct discussions with potential contractors, accept revisions to proposals, and negotiate price changes at the discretion of the selection committee.

During the discussion period, all information regarding proposal submittals will remain confidential.

Upon execution of a contract, the proposals will become public record and contents will be available upon request.

F. AWARD

The contract award shall be made to the responsible Respondent whose proposal is determined to be the most advantageous to CMC based on the criteria and information provided in the RFP.

Ennovate and CMC reserve the right to ask for the "Best and Final Offer".

G. PROTESTS

Any actual or prospective bidder, offeror, contractor, or citizen who is aggrieved in connection with the solicitation process or award of the contract may protest in writing to the selection committee, care of Adam Allington.



A protest must be submitted within three working days from the time when the aggrieved person knows or should have reasonably known the facts giving rise to the protest.

Protest procedure time limit may be extended upon mutual agreement of the selection committee and the aggrieved party.

Protestors may file a protest on any phase of the solicitation, bid, proposal, or award.

The written protest must include the following as a minimum: name and address of the protestor, identification of the RFP document, statement of reason for the protest, and any exhibits, evidence, or document substantiating the protest.

The selection committee shall provide written determination to the protestor within three working days after receiving all relevant, requested information.

#### H. CONTRACT

The Respondent chosen by Ennovate and CMC to provide the services shall enter into a Contract with CMC prior to delivering the services. The Contract will be in form and content satisfactory to CMC in all aspects and will contain all provisions set forth in this RFP ("RFP Terms"), unless otherwise agreed by CMC. If Respondent takes exception to any RFP Terms, Respondent shall submit a detailed written explanation of such exceptions as part of its Proposal. Respondent's exceptions will be reviewed by Ennovate and CMC and may result in disqualification of Respondent's Proposal as non-responsive to this RFP. If Respondent's exceptions do not result in disqualification, Ennovate and CMC will consider such exceptions when evaluating Respondent's Proposal. As part of its Proposal, Respondent shall include its Contract draft which must clearly indicate that: (i) this RFP, Respondent's Proposal and the RFP Terms (collectively, "RFP Documents") are all material parts of the Contract; and (ii) the RFP Documents will prevail in the event of any inconsistency between the RFP Documents and any other provision of the Contract. Prior to submitting its Proposal, Respondent will sufficiently modify its proposed Contract form to fully incorporate the RFP Documents and to eliminate any inconsistency between the RFP Documents and other provisions in the Contract. When submitting its Contract draft to Ennovate and CMC, Respondent shall also include either: (i) a redlined/tracked changes version of the Contract reflecting inclusion of the RFP Documents; or (ii) a cross-reference guide clearly identifying where in the Contract each of the RFP Documents has been incorporated.



I. INDEMNIFICATION

The successful contractor shall indemnify and save Ennovate and CMC harmless, to the extent permitted by law.

J. ILLEGAL ALIENS

By submitting a bid, the contractor certifies pursuant to C.R.S. § 8-17.5-102 that, at the time of bid submission, it does not knowingly employ or contract with an illegal alien and that the contractor has confirmed the employment eligibility of all employees newly hired for employment to perform work under the public contract for services through participation in either the E-Verify Program or the Department Program.
